1 Adoption

... to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons. **GALATIANS 4:5**

To be adopted into God's family is to receive full rights and privileges as a son or daughter, equal to other biological children in the family. This means we share legal rights and resources as God's children. According to Galatians 3:28, what barriers has God broken for us to be part of His family?

2 Intimacy

And because you are sons, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!" **GALATIANS 4:6**

3 Inheritance
